LAST WEEK AT LEHIGH KIWANIS CLUB:

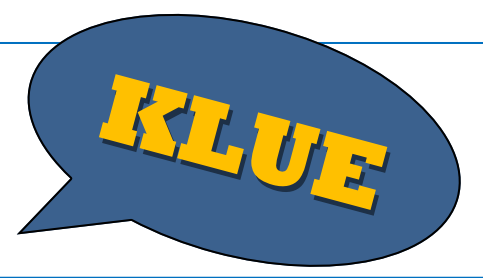
